Background Information

VASP belongs to the Ena/VASP family. Ena/VASP proteins are actin-associated proteins involved in a range of $processes\ dependent\ on\ cytoskeleton\ remodeling\ and\ cell\ polarity\ such\ as\ axon\ guidance,\ lamellipodial\ and\ and\ cell\ polarity\ such\ as\ axon\ guidance,\ lamellipodial\ and\ lamellipodial\ and\ lamellipodial\ and\ lamellipodial\ and\ lamellipodial\ and\ lamellipodial\ and\ lamellipodial\ l$ filopodial dynamics, platelet activation and cell migration. VASP promotes actin filament elongation. It protects the barbed end of growing actin filaments against capping and increases the rate of actin polymerization in the presence of capping protein. VASP stimulates actin filament elongation by promoting the transfer of profilin-bound actin monomers onto the barbed end of growing actin filaments. VASP plays a role in actin-based mobility of Listeria monocytogenes in host cells. Regulates actin dynamics in platelets and plays an important role in $regulating\ platelet\ aggregation.\ Human\ platelet\ activation\ is\ inhibited\ by\ agents\ such\ as\ prostaglandins\ and\ NO$ donors, which elevate cAMP or cGMP levels. VASP is phosphorylated in human platelets in response to both cAMPand cGMP-elevating agents, and its phosphorylation correlates with platelet inhibition. VASP is located about 92 kb distal to ERCC1 (126380) and about 300 kb proximal to the myotonic dystrophy protein kinase gene. The antibody is specific to VASP.



Various lysates were subjected to SDS PAGE followed by western blot with 68431-1-lg (VASP antibody) at dilution of 1:20000 incubated at room temperature for 1.5 hours. The membrane was stripped and reblotted with HRP-conjugated GAPDH Monoclonal antibody (HRP-60004) as loading control. This data was developed using the same antibody clone with 68431-1-PBS in a different storage buffer formulation.
